Private territory, situated close to the Mickai, Klaipėda region. Directions:

1. Take road No. 141 from Klaipėda (Šilutė direction)

Site

The site is composed by a track with 120 * 10 meters, or grass runway - 150*20 meters, Mickai - 12 km from the centre of Klaipeda.

Sporting Licences

Every competitor must have a valid Sporting Licence of the FAI Sporting Licence Database. The organizer will check licences in the database before the competition

Classes of the Competition:

F3A (FAI schedule (preliminary (P23) and final (F23) schedules

Competition:

- 1. Four (4) FAI P23 rounds
- 2. Two (2) FAI F23 rounds
- 3. Three (3) C national

Considering the weather conditions, the number of rounds can change

Rules of the Competition:

The basic rules are:

The competition will be run in accordance with the FAI Sporting Code. Volume F3, RC Aerobatics.

Rounds schedule according Annex 5N.3

FAI schedule - Four (4) P19 rounds and two (2) F19 rounds will be flown during the competition. One preliminary round and one final round with the lowest scores will be eliminated. Final result will be calculated from the Three best preliminary rounds and plus one best the final round.
